You'll find us half way between Sydney and Melbourne, approx. 500km to each and a short 40km to Wagga Wagga, The Coolamon Shire LGA covers 2,494 square kilometres within the Riverina Region of NSW. Coolamon Shire is comprised of the three larger towns of Coolamon, Ganmain and Ardlethan and the smaller villages of Marrar, Matong and Beckom. The Wiradjuri people were the first to the region. Coolamon is named after the Wiradjuri word for a vessel for carrying goods, children and water – "Gullaman'. Coolamon was established around the time the railway arrived in 1881, with the Shire being proclaimed on 3 March 1906.

The Coolamon Shire is one of the richest agricultural and pastoral districts in the Riverina. Surrounded by Bland, Narrandera, Junee and Temora Shires and the City of Wagga Wagga to the south.




COMMUNITY COMMITTEES

JUSTICE OF THE PEACE

Many of Council's staff are Justices of the Peace (JP) and can assist residents with these services free of charge. JP's are available within the Coolamon Shire Council Office and the Coolamon Shire Library.

JP's can assist with the following services:

- A statutory declaration which is a written statement which a person declares to be true in the presence of an authorised witness.
- An affidavit which is a written statement for use as evidence in court proceedings.
- A certified copy of an original document may be required by various organisations.

STREET STALLS AND SATURDAY MORNING RAFFLES

Bookings for street stalls in Coolamon and Ganmain can be made by phoning the Council Office during business hours. To keep this fair, only one street stall may be held at any one time.


The principal organisation may only have two bookings per annum and may only have one booking at any one time in advance. Approvals for street stalls and raffles are restricted to organisations from within the Shire. Combined street stall and raffle to be held on Fridays. Raffle only to be held on Saturday mornings. The bookings for the above are to be held by different organisations. Bookings for street stalls in Ardlethan are administered and monitored by the Ardlethan Central School. One organisation can hold a stall or raffle per week, the choice of day is at the discretion of the organisation but only one can be held per week.

AUSTRALIA DAY CELEBRATIONS

Coolamon Shire Council celebrates Australia Day in a different town or village each year. This is rotated across our communities. All residents in the Shire are invited to attend this event where community members are recognized through the various Australia Day awards.

Pets are a big part of families and bring so much joy, but it's important to make sure your pet is taken care of and does not cause a nuisance to neighbours and the wider community. Please ensure they are registered and microchipped. This helps us find you if they happen to wander from their home.

All dogs must be microchipped and registered. They must be microchipped by a Vet or authorised agent by 12 weeks of age and then registered by the age of 6 months at your local Council or any Council within NSW.

Your dog is required by law, when in a public place, to be under effective control at all times and have a collar with a tag attached that shows the contact details of the dog's owner.


Cats must be microchipped by 12 weeks of age and registered by 6 months of age. If the cat is microchipped it can be identified on the Companion Animals register.

Please visit Council's website for information regarding registration rates for your pet.

If you have a noisy dog nearby, Council recommends talking to your neighbour first and if the issue continues the next step is to contact Council.

If you suspect an animal is being mistreated, contact an RSPCA inspector on (02) 9770 7555 or 1300 278 3589, or visit the RSPCA website.

If you want to keep livestock on your residential property please contact council to discuss limitations, restrictions and guidelines. Council will refer you to any relevant external contacts where possible.





In the case of an emergency, always call '000'.

It is the duty of the owner or occupier of land to take the notified steps and any other practicable steps to prevent the occurrence of bushfires and to minimise the danger of the spread of bushfires on that land.

FIREBREAK REQUIREMENTS

During fire season Council requires the owner or occupier of any land within the Shire, exceeding 4 hectares (10 acres) in area, to make and maintain firebreaks surrounding the entire property, or as near as practicable thereto by ploughing to a width of not less than 3 metres. Information regarding firebreak requirements can be found on Council's website.

FIRE HAZARD COMPLAINTS ON OVERGROWN BLOCKS OF LAND

If the land is owned by Coolamon Shire Council please phone Council on 6930 1800 to make a report.

If the hazard is on privately owned land, please contact the owner of the land.

If the land is not mown/slashed then contact the council or phone Wagga Wagga Rural Fire Service (Riverina) on 02 6971 4500 to report.


PERMITS TO BURN

A Fire Permit is required for burning activities during the Bush Fire Danger Period in Rural Fire districts and at all times in Fire and Rescue districts around the state. Fire Permits help ensure fire is used safely and minimise the danger to you, your property and the community.

The Bush Fire Danger Period runs from 1 October to 31 March, however it may vary due to local conditions. If you are planning to light a fire in the open during this time, you will need a Fire Permit. More information regarding permits and how to apply can be found on www.rfs.nsw.gov.au

WASTE AND Recycling

Council's Waste and Recycling services include domestic collections for general waste and recyclables, tip (landfill) operations and hard waste collections.

We are dedicated to keeping Coolamon Shire a clean and tidy area, this is the responsibility of all residents. The following information provides details regarding Council's waste management.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING KEBSIDE COLLECTION

Each of the Shire's towns and villages are serviced by a weekly domestic waste collection and a fortnightly recycling collection. Coolamon and Ganmain are serviced by an organics and green waste collection on alternate fortnights to the recycling collection.

It's important to ensure you are recycling the right items. REROC has launched a campaign 'Recycle Night? Recycle Right!' to assist with emphasising what items can be recycled. You can read more here www. recyclenight.org.au

To assist with your collection, please place your bin kerb side, clear of anything that would stop the truck from collecting. Please ensure your lid is closed. Once emptied, your bin is to be stored back on your property. It is preferred that general waste is bagged before being placed in the bins or taken to landfill, this helps to keep our sites clean.

LANDFILL SITES (TIPS)

Council operates garbage landfill sites in Ardlethan, Coolamon, Ganmain and Marrar. Tip opening times are available on Council's website. Coolamon Shire Council's rates notices include a waste charge which allows residents of the Shire to deposit domestic waste at the landfill sites all year round, at no additional fee. As a new resident it is advised that you carry some identification with you when accessing the landfill sites. Non-residents can access the landfill site, however, there will be a fee for this service.

If you are disposing of commercial and/or builders waste/rubble, asbestos, mattresses/non-recyclable furniture, car tyres and animal bodies a fee will be charged to all landfill users (residents and nonresidents).

HARD WASTE COLLECTION

Household Kerb side collection clean-up for residents is held annually. This provides collection for larger items such as whitegoods, furniture, carpet and small appliances. Items should be placed out for pick up on the night before collection. Further information regarding this service is made available via Council's website, newsletter and Facebook page.

E-WASTE FACILITY

An e-waste facility is now available at the Coolamon landfill site. e-waste must be disposed of separately. This includes the collection of computers, laptops, monitors, TV's, DVD/CD/VHS players, printers, small electrical appliances, mobile phones, microwaves and game consoles. If items like these make it into landfill they can contain substances that can be environmentally toxic. Recycling e-waste means that a large percentage of the materials can be recovered and recycled into new products.

COMMUNITY RECYCLING STATIONS

Council with the support of REROC have installed a Community Recycling Stations at the following locations:

COOLAMON LANDFILL

This station allows residents to drop off larger items for recycling. Items that are eligible for drop off include gas bottles, paint, household and car batteries, fluoro globes and tubes, motor oils, smoke detectors and electronic waste.

COOLAMON SHIRE LIBRARY

This station allows residents to recycle various household problem wastes free of charge. Items that are able to be recycled include household batteries, smoke detectors, mobile phones and accessories, and fluorescent globes.

COOLAMON LIONS CLUB RECYCLING

The Coolamon Lions Club operate their recycling service for cardboard and paper only, with the addition of systems to take aluminum cans to be put in place in the future. Residents of Coolamon Shire are encouraged to use this service. Recyclables can be taken to the Lions Club Recycling Shed which is located behind the Scout Hall off Loughnan Street Coolamon. Bins are clearly labelled indicated the placement of items. For further information, please contact Lions Club member David McCann on 02 6927 2379.



If you are intending to build, develop or use land, it is recommended to speak to Council's planning team first for advice:

- Development assessment process
- Rules and requirements for developing at the particular site
- Discuss any issues that might affect your proposed development

HERITAGE ADVICE

The Coolamon Shire area prides itself on preserving and protecting our beautiful heritage. Council works with a Heritage Advisor and has a Heritage Advisory Committee to assist with heritage listed properties. Please note that heritage related development applications are also referred to Council's Heritage Advisor. It is recommended to contact Council and the Heritage Advisor in your early planning stages.

SWIMMING POOLS

As a home owner or resident it is important that your pool or spa are registered correctly and have the necessary requirements. The most important aspect of owning a pool is the responsibility of providing and maintaining the pool fence to an appropriate standard that restricts the entry of small children.

Council has a responsibility to ensure that all swimming pools are fenced in accordance with the Acts and Regulations. The definition of swimming pool is any excavation, structure or vessel that is principally used for swimming, wading etc. with a depth greater than 300mm.




The RRL Mobile Library visits Ardelthan on a fortnightly basis.

YOUTH

HOME CARE PACKAGES

Offering a number of packages of aged care services for Shire residents which assist older people who wish to remain living in their homes and local communities.

Funding for these packages of flexible services have been provided by the Department of Health and are administered through Allawah Community Care.

The range of services offered may include showering, light housework, laundry, shopping, monitoring medication, light maintenance and/or assistance with meals.

COMMUNITY TRANSPORT

Providing transport for older people and their carers. Services may also be available to isolated people who have difficulty accessing public or private transport. Services are mostly provided by volunteers using safe and modern cars. This service is eligible for residents needing to travel to Temora, Griffith, Narrandera, Wagga Wagga, Junee and other destinations available by arrangements. Bookings are essential and it is necessary to provide at least 24-hour notice for your trips.


HOME & COMMUNITY CARE SERVICES

Offering services including meals, home maintenance and modifications, social support, respite and domestic assistance.

- The meals service is primarily through Meals on Wheels frozen meal delivery service. Some people prefer to pick their meals up from the Allawah Community Centre however, weekly deliveries can be made within Coolamon and to surrounding towns within the Shire. Volunteers deliver meals to those who are unable to come to Allawah Community Care Office and collect meals for themselves. A list of meal choices and heating instructions is available from the Allawah Community Care office.
- Home Modification work can include, installation of handrails, handheld showers, tap turners and ramps, rebuilding steps to accommodate walking frames and applications for extensive modifications to keep you living in your own home for as long as possible.
- Home Maintenance service provides a qualified person (through Coolamon Shire Council approved contract) that provides basic yard maintenance which includes whipper snipping, lawn mowing, gutter cleaning and weeding.
- Social Support service provides a range of basic support services to assist in meeting someone's need for social contact and/or a companion in order to participate in community life. This enables elderly to enjoy life more fully and develop friendships with people in the wider community through social interaction. This may include events, shopping, small group activities, visiting friends, phoning friends and/ or attending appointments.

- Domestic Assistance. Tasks such as simple meal preparation, light housework and putting the bins out are examples of the services provided through the Domestic Assistance program.
- Respite can be arranged for limited amounts of time in your own home. This service allows time for a carer to be able to leave the home and attend to their own appointments, shopping etc knowing your loved one is being cared for. Respite care can be arranged with a care worker and if you care for someone and need time away from the home, please ring Allawah Community Care and talk about your situation and every effort will be made to assist you.
